Duke was an exceptional student and was pursuing a degree in quantitative economics with the goal of becoming a naval aviator and professional pilot. As he was unable to achieve that goal, the foundation is committed to helping others attain their aviation goals in his place and is excited to announce Fly For Duke. Beginning in 2024, The Duke Carrillo Foundation will offer one Fly For Duke aviation scholarship per year to an aspiring aviator between the ages of 18 and 23 to earn a private pilot's license. Fly For Duke will include financial assistance and mentoring to support and guide the recipients as they go through their training. The Duke Carrillo Foundation will continue to provide scholarships to graduation seniors with a family history of military service and to fund the Duke Carrillo Scholars Fund at the United States Naval Academy.
